# Inflation, Employment, Business and Consumer Confidence Indicators

EMPLOYMENT: Weekly initial unemployment claims were 222,000 down 13k from the prior week. November's net new jobs came in at a 266k vs prior month's 128k. The unemployment rate decreased from 3.6% to 3.5%.


INFLATION: Nov's CPI decreased from 0.4% to 0.3% Core remained at 0.2%

Producer Price Index decreased from 0.4% to 0.0% as energy and gas prices increases slowed. (this is a relatively volatile index). Core PPI increased from 0.0% to 0.2%.


Consumer Confidence has vacillated over the past couple of months. It decreased from 126.1 to 125.5 in Nov.

Leading Business Indicators has been (0.2%) and improved to 0.0% in Nov


# Inflation: Consumer Price Index (CPI) and Producer Price Index (PPI)




#### **Employment: Monthly New Jobs Created and Unemployment Rate**
